


# What is the AP SPANISH Language & Culture Exam?

- College Board: AP Program created by www.collegeboard.org
- 4 hour Examination: measures a student's Spanish language proficiency in reading, writing, speaking, and listening.
- College Credit: if student passes with a 3, 4 or 5 they are eligible to apply for college credit
- Colleges & Universities: Over 2,000 accept scores


# SCORES



Longfellow AP Pass Rates (3+)




#### AP SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE COURSE


- Prepares students to pass the exam.


