Students will have 5 minutes at the beginning and end of class to change.

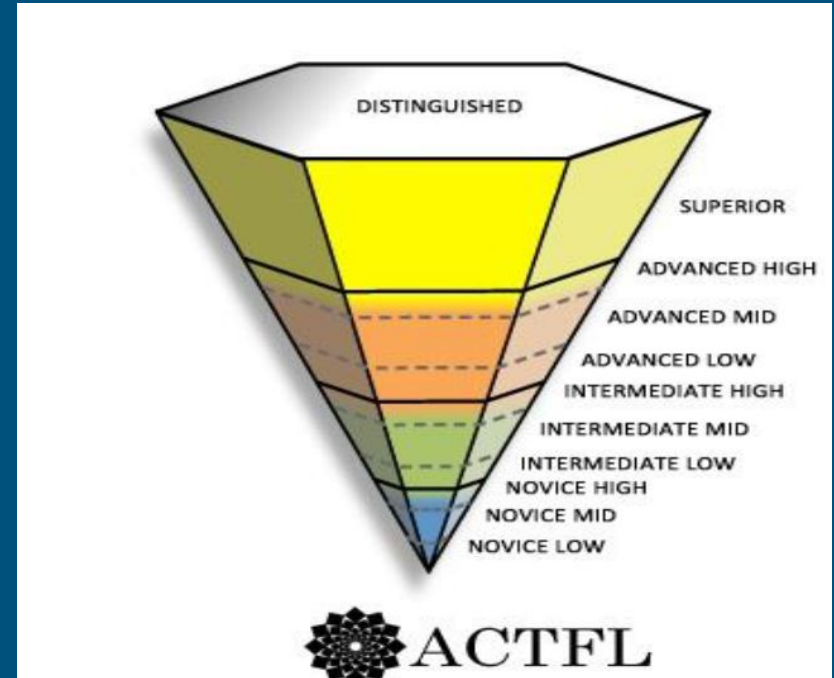
Students will need to purchase a combination lock for their locker.

Goals
